

Neonatal – Malrotation & Volvulus

Course Description: This module discusses malrotation and volvulus in newborns, as well as annular pancreas, Hirschsprung's, and meconium ileus. It discusses signs and symptoms, initial management, and the Ladd Procedure for malrotation and volvulus. A case scenario tests student understanding of the material.
